Saturday 10th May 2008:

Wado Kyu Grade

1.00pm to 3.50pm

This Seminar is open to Wado practitioners from 9th kyu and above. This program will be under the instruction of Colin Clapperton 7th Dan who will be assisted by many of the SKF's senior grades.

It should be noted at this time, the current criteria for Dan grade promotion within the Scottish Karate Federation is under review. In anticipation of any changes made, attendance at this seminar will be recorded and SKF licence holders will have their license stamped accordingly.

Every third student from the same family will train for free. (This includes parents and children attending at different seminars.)
